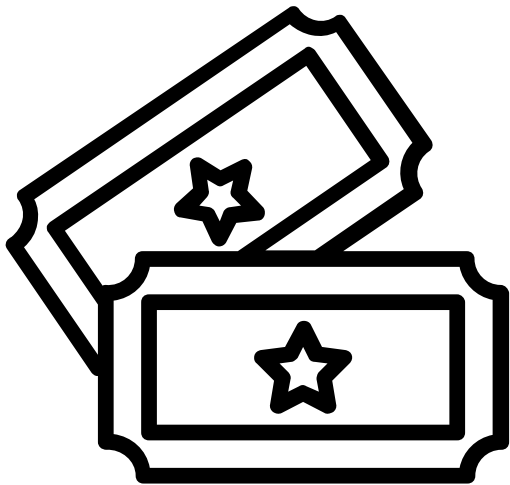

Are you ready to turn in your raffle tickets? Follow the steps below:

Present your completed passport at a participating museum by July 31, or bring it to the Closing Event at Brazoria County Historical Museum on Saturday, August 1 from 10 AM - 12 PM to submit your raffle entry/entries. Once it has been checked, you will fill out one raffle ticket for collecting 9 stamps, or both for collecting 12+. You will then cut them out and turn them in.

Raffle tickets cannot be turned in without showing your passport to museum staff or volunteers!

You may keep your passport after turning in raffle tickets.

Important information on each museum, such as address, open hours, and admission fees (if applicable), is listed in this passport. You do NOT need to visit sites in any particular order!
